Required Documents

No matter which training program you wish to enroll in, the following documents are **required** to be signed and uploaded to your *Flight Circle* account. Please contact one of our team members to assist in this process if needed.

Medical Certificate	 Recommended to obtain a medical certificate prior to starting flight training 1st or 2nd class medical is required for financing through <i>Stratus Financial</i>.
Valid Driver's License	State issued driver's license
Unexpired U.S. Passport	• If you do not have a U.S. Passport, you may use an official Birth Certificate.
Student or Pilot Certificate	• Information also to be updated in your <i>Flight Circle</i> account.
Renter's Insurance	 Must have prior to solo flight in one of our aircraft. Can be purchased from our website. Not required to have to start training
Legal, Liability, and Operational Contracts	• Will be reviewed and signed when creating your <i>Flight Circle</i> account.

Flight Circle Overview

We utilize Flight Circle as our primary scheduling and managing software that both our Students and Instructors use. The majority of our onboarding process takes place once you create an account. You will be able to schedule appointments with an aircraft, simulator, classroom, and instructor, all in one easy to use platform.

- To set up an account, contact one of the Nightline Air staff members (Zach Powell) or one of our Certified Flight Instructors (CFI). We'll need your <u>first and last name, email address, and phone number.</u> We will send you an email with a generated password that you will be able to change once you login on your side. In addition, use this <u>link</u> to create an account yourself and one of the staff members will accept you. Be sure to send one of these staff members a text message or call to ensure we know we can approve your access.

- 2. Flight Circle does not have a mobile app to download. However, it is fully fitted to work on a desktop computer, iPad, Android tablet, iPhone, or Android Phone. It is highly recommended to pull up Flight Circle on your internet browser on your mobile phone/device and then select "Send to Home Screen" Once you click this button, it will create a "shortcut" to your home screen and the program will be fitted to act and look like any ordinary app.
- 3. Once you are all logged into Flight Circle, take a few minutes and really navigate around the program to become familiar with it. There are a lot of features and functions associated with this program. Take advantage of the tools and information you can find in this program that we have setup for you.
 - a. This is also the time you will sign and upload the required documents to your account.
 - b. You can change the layout of the calendar to horizontal, vertical, daily, and other modes.
- 4. Two important sections in Flight Circle are "<u>Dashboard</u>" and "<u>Files</u>". The Dashboard section is a list of updates that come out periodically including events and promotions. This is useful in keeping up with what is going on in our group. The other section located around the Dashboard is the Files section. Here you will find our "<u>Sign up</u>" documents and aircraft documents specified by tail number. In addition, you will see a variety of hand created documents such as weight and balance and airworthiness sheets, training materials, ACS manuals, syllabuses, and more.

- 5. Locate your pilot profile section. At the top are four sections:
 - a. Ledger: This is your financial summary
 - b. Personal: Personal information
 - c. **Pilot:** Pilot information and requirements
 - d. **Files:** Upload your profile picture, sign up documents, and other documents between you and management & your flight instructor
- 6. Once you have your Flight Circle setup, Files signed and uploaded to your account on Flight Circle, you can schedule a flight or two with one of our Certified Flight Instructors. Whether you are a new student or coming to rent, set up some appointments to get you started and we will work with you individually to the specific steps we need to take.
- For payment options, please ask your flight instructor or Zach Powell. We accept credit or debit cards. *Please note:* a saved credit or debit card is required to have on file in your account. <u>We do not accept Amex Cards at this time.</u>



Training Materials

We primarily utilize **Sporty's** training program in our curriculum. We have our own Pilot Shop full of all training materials, courses, pilot and aircraft supplies, bags, and more. One of our instructors will set you up with the necessary training items that will benefit you for training. Don't stress on finding the materials on your own!

• The Pilot Shop is OPEN for non-enrolled pilots. The Shop is for public use!
